


A century after its birth, psychoanalysis faces many challenges. If his practice arouses so much expectation, if its results are significant, if enthusiasm for this profession continues to grow, his thinking is in crisis. This crisis is inevitable and regular, which is why each analyst is "forced to reinvent psychoanalysis". This reinvention is necessitated by the criticisms it receives, and which are understood, as much as by the incomprehension of its advances. This misunderstanding is due both to the specific difficulties of its transmission and to contemporary cultural upheavals – the digital revolution as well as the simultaneous growth of a new scientism and a return of religion – but also geopolitical - with the return of violent until then distant and exercised far from the muffled tranquility of the Western world: there were many disturbances in the distance but the ordinary quickly regained its rights, especially as the conviction that we were on the road to progress took over us. However, today we are experiencing a sudden change in the world which leads us to re-examine what new issues it produces. Psychoanalysts from many places, from many countries will come, to Paris and by videoconference,

from December 12 to 15, 2024, to exchange and transmit the state of their work.


